This historic property has more than 700 guestrooms and is known as America’s resort with three championship golf courses. The elegant Greenbrier Hotel is a National Historic Landmark. Built at the dawn of tourism in the United States, this great resort hotel has hosted presidents, royals and a burgeoning middle class. Even after ambitious restorations, this grand dame remains true to its roots and place in American history. From statesman Henry Clay to Princess Grace of Monaco, legions of famous guests have stayed at the Greenbrier in White Sulphur Springs, West Virginia over the past 200 years.

**Day 1, Tues., Nov. 27 – Chattanooga** – Motor coach from Zachary and Baton Rouge through Hammond to Chattanooga for overnight.

**Day 2, Wed., Nov. 28 – The Greenbrier** – Travel through beautiful eastern Tennessee and the scenic Shenandoah Valley of Virginia for mid-afternoon arrival at the Greenbrier Hotel in White Sulphur Springs, West Virginia for a two night stay in the heart of the Alleghany Mountains. Hotel check-in time is 4:00 p.m. Tonight dinner is not included. Several restaurants are available.

**Day 3, Thurs., Nov. 29 – The Greenbrier** – After included breakfast at the Greenbrier we will tour the historic hotel, a guided tour of the grounds on a hotel bus, as well as the Cold War Bunkers. This afternoon enjoy an included afternoon tea and tonight we have included dinner in the main dining hall.

**Day 4, Fri., Nov. 30 – Knoxville, Tennessee** – After our included hotel breakfast and a leisurely morning, we will check-out at approximately 11:00 a.m. We will then enjoy lunch (on your own) and shopping in the local village of Tamarack, the arts and crafts center of West Virginia. Overnight in Knoxville.

**Day 5, Sat., Dec. 1** – Full day drive home, arriving in Baton Rouge at approximately 7:00 p.m.

**THE LAST RESORT** – Uncle Sam has long depended on the Greenbrier for more than just R & R. At the start of World War II, the government leased the hotel to house foreign diplomats and their families until they could be exchanged for American diplomats in Axis countries. Later in the war the Army converted the resort into a hospital for soldiers. But Greenbrier’s most notorious official gig came during the Cold War, when the government built a bunker on the property to house the U.S. Congress in case of any attack. “Project Greek Island” was in a constant state of operational readiness until 1992 when a Washington Post article blew its cover and the bunker was decommissioned.
